NARRATIVE:

The University of Florida Police Department, with the assistance of the Gainesville Police Department, will be conducting a Driving Under the Influence (DUI) Traffic Checkpoint beginning Thursday, October 20 at 10:00 p.m. and concluding at 3:30 a.m. on Friday, October 21, 2005.

The checkpoint will be staged on Gale Lemerand Drive, South of Museum Road, adjacent to the Large Commuter parking lot. All vehicular traffic will be routed from the two North and South bound lanes to one lane each way at the checkpoint.

Officers will be checking for valid driver's license, proof of insurance, current registration, seatbelt violations and visible signs of DUI. The UFPD is extremely proactive regarding DUI enforcement, and this checkpoint is just one way of keeping impaired drivers off the streets of our campus.
